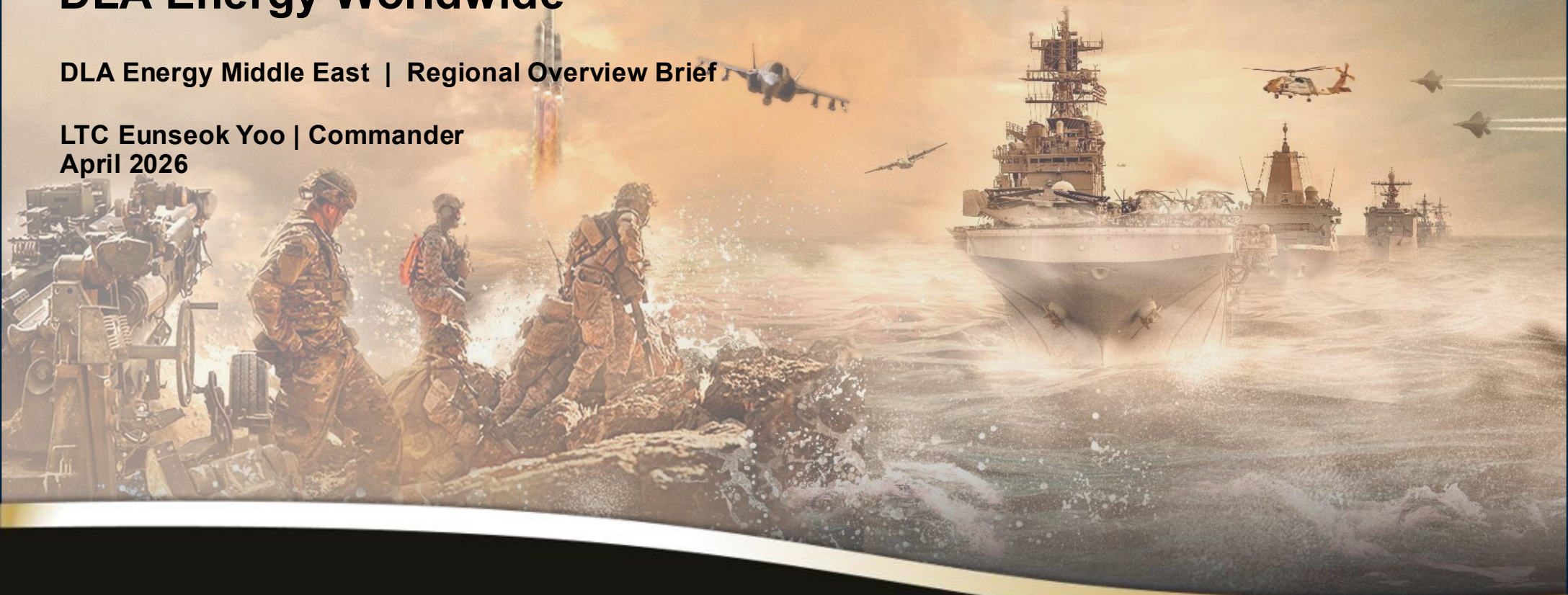

## Mission Overview



**Mission:** Provide the War Department and its foreign partners with seamless, uninterrupted energy in the CENTCOM AOR. Always ready to support the Warfighter and our nation's global logistics requirements!

### Operational Capability

#### Contracts

- 43 contracts across 14 countries valued at \$3.42B
  - 4 Into-Plane (ITP) contracts | 8 countries
  - 9 Bunker contracts | 6 countries

#### [Capitalized] Defense Fuel Support Points (DFSP)

- 14 DFSPs | 6 countries

#### Direct Delivery Fuels (DDF)

- 22 DDF sites | 9 countries

#### International Agreements [ACSA]

- Acquisition & Cross-Servicing Agreements | 14 countries

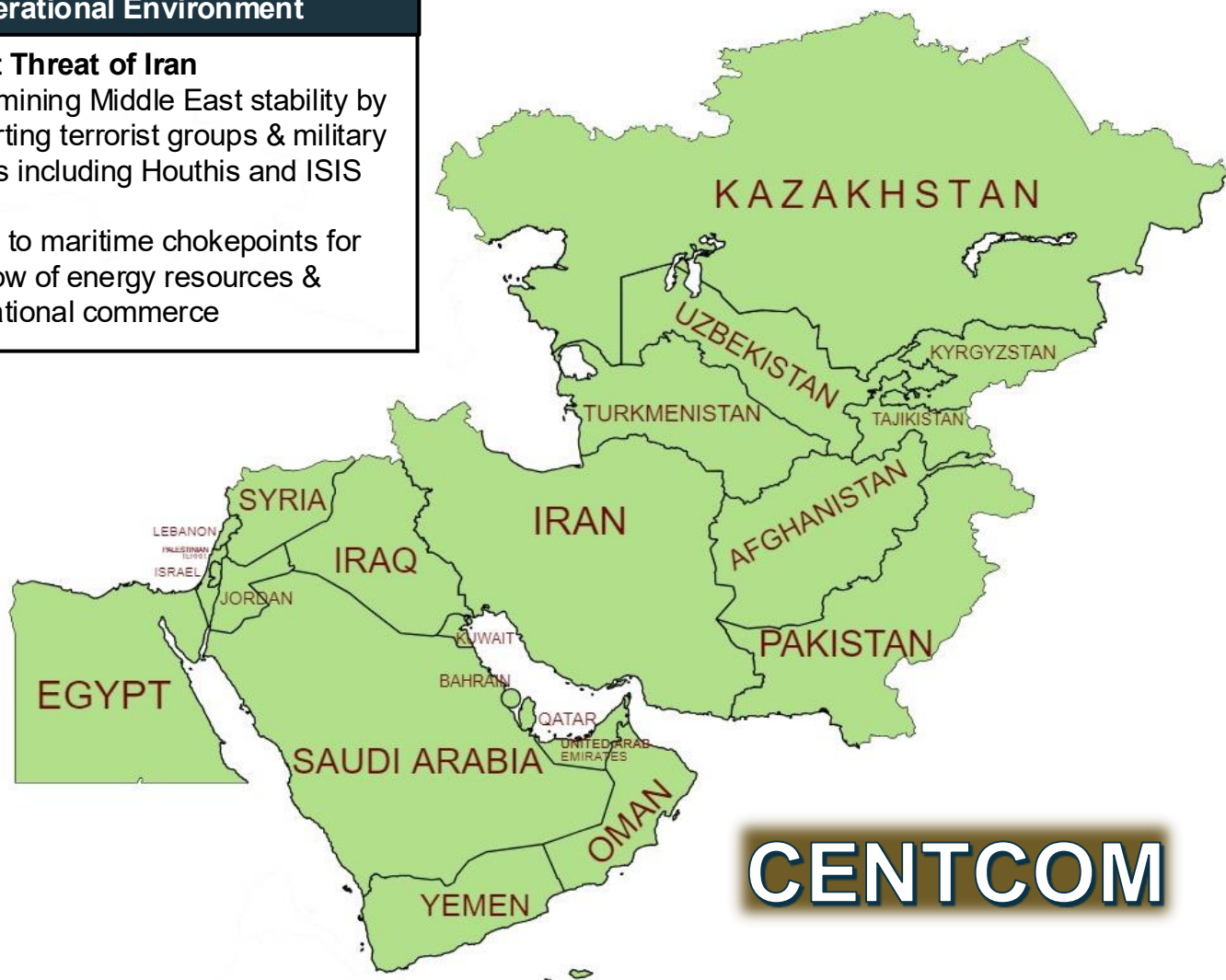

### Operational Environment

#### Persistent Threat of Iran

- Undermining Middle East stability by supporting terrorist groups & military proxies including Houthis and ISIS

# CENTCOM



### Customer Operations

Provides end-to-end fuel support for 22 sites supported via 13 Direct Delivery Fuels contracts [37 Contract Line-Item Numbers] across 9 countries valued at **\$12M monthly** directly supporting the Warfighter at the operational & tactical levels through:

- Forecasting
- Planning
- Ordering
- Delivering
- Invoicing
- Monitoring

#### CY25 Accomplishments

- **First ever** U.S. Embassy Tashkent fuel support contract awarded, totaling \$2.1M (312K USG)
- **Generated 461 Purchase Orders** totaling \$143.2M (41M USG)
- Assisted U.S. Consulate Erbil expansion with fuel support contract totaling \$10.3M (3.8M USG)
- **Accepted 740 invoices** in Wide Area Workflow totaling \$65M (15.6M USG)
- **Supported HA** for Operation C.A.R.E. [Qatar] totaling \$27M (1M USG)

### Supplier Operations

Oversees petroleum operations and inventory management of all Defense Fuel Support Points (DFSPs), International Agreements, and petroleum support contracts in CENTCOM AOR.

#### CY25 Accomplishments

- Hosted a Vendor Workshop **for 30 Omani vendors**
- **Closed out \$1.15M** of aged debt with Qatar
- 14 Multi-lateral exercises supported [1.6M USG | \$5.3M]
- **Closed multiple** Purchase and Sell ACSA Orders **dated back to 2021 with Israel and UAE** MoD totaling \$20.4M
- **First ever** long-term Bunker contract for JP5 and F76 in Yanbu & Jeddah, KSA

### Quality Assurance

Oversees quality assurance and quality surveillance on all bulk petroleum related products in CENTCOM AOR.

- Bulk Fuel, Posts Camps and Stations, Cryogenics, Bunkers, & Into-Plane Contracts
- Laboratory and Inspection Service Contracts
- Secure Fuels Missions & Exercise Support
- Pre/Post-Award Surveys
- Invoice Inspection
- Vessel Internal Tank Inspections

#### CY25 Accomplishments

- 5 pipeline operations totaling 65.1M USG
- **7 Secure Fuels** missions totaling 42K USG
- **12 vessel loads** totaling 153M USG
- 21 vessel discharges totaling 311.8K USG
- **84 Bunker PAS** at 23 CENTCOM locations
- 91 Aviation Breathing Oxygen cylinders inspected

## DDF

### Challenges | Opportunities | Way Ahead

- **Challenge:** Supporting Operation INHERENT RESOLVE through myriad restrictions posed by Iraq's Prime Minister's National Operations Center often affecting vendor movement to and from local refineries
- **Opportunity:** Whole-of-government fuel support initiatives for U.S. Embassies throughout CENTCOM
- **Way Ahead:** Postured for the future fight with emerging CENTCOM Operations in Gaza and Syria

## DFSP | ACSA

### Challenges | Opportunities | Way Ahead

- **Challenge:** Getting partner nations to sign ACSA Orders in a timely manner / Aged debt / Site optimization
- **Opportunity:** Support NAVCENT's plan to make Duqm a "logistics hub" with the establishment of a long-term fuel solution in Duqm, Oman
- **Way Ahead:** Continue to strengthen relationships and interoperability by providing host nation partners value-added programs such as Vendor Workshops and Fuels Lab Training, in collaboration with the Services

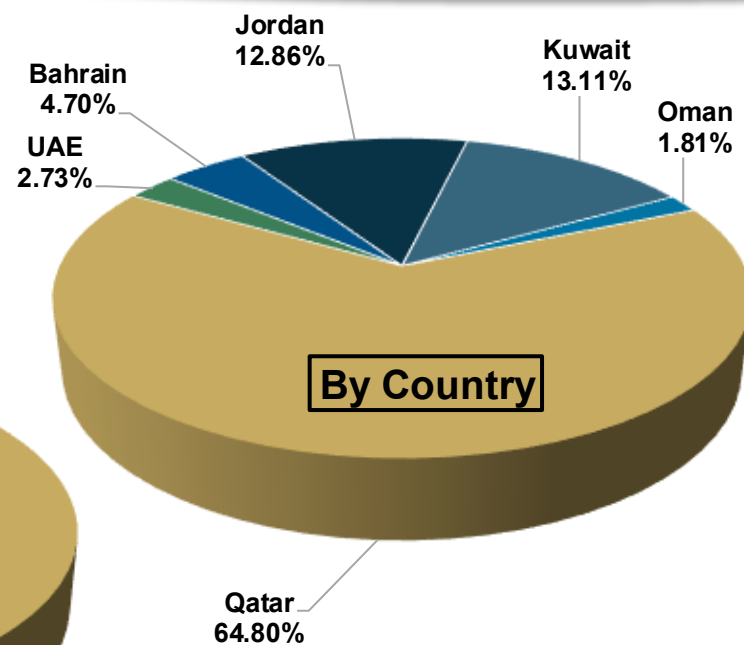
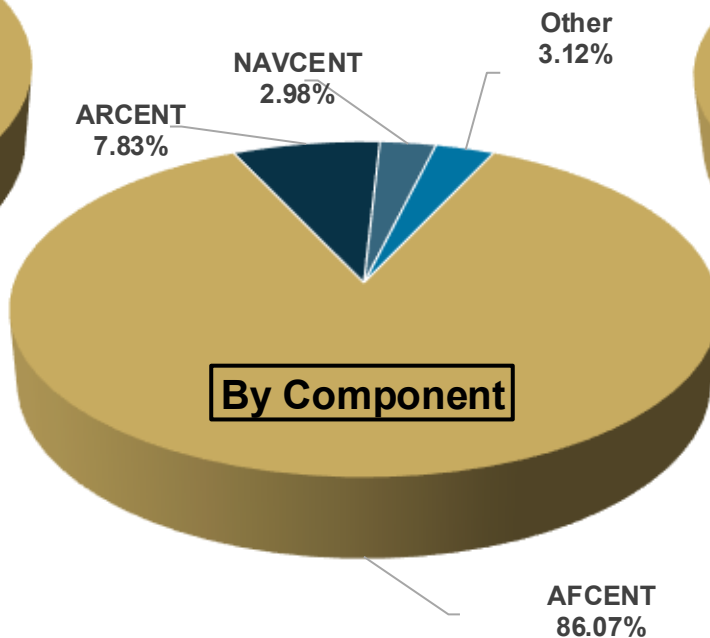
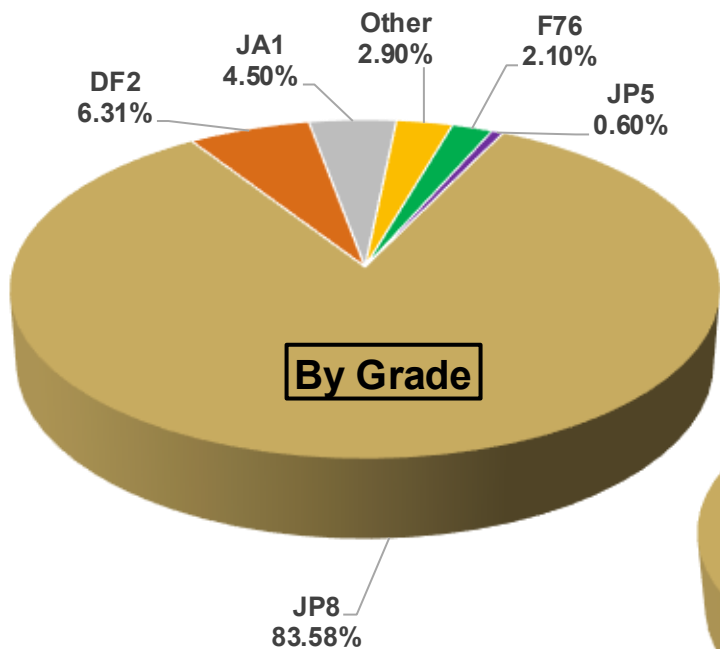
## Quality Assurance

### Challenges | Opportunities | Way Ahead

- **Challenge:** New 30-day lead time requirement to enter DFSP Mesaieed [Qatar] vice 10—supports DFSP Al Udeid [Qatar] and largest customer [AFCENT]
- **Opportunity:** Host the J10 Quality Course and invite host nation partners to promote knowledge and burden sharing, enhance their fuel operations proficiency and foster a unified approach to logistical support
- **Way Ahead:** Establish DLA Energy approved regional labs
