- Approaches to Utility Resilience on Govt. Installations
 - Renewals and Replacements
 - Avoiding deferred recapitalization
 - System Owner's strategic upgrades
 - Government-funded capital upgrades
 - MILCON funded resilience measures (e.g., Energy Resilience Capital Investment Program [ERCIP])
- Demonstrating Resilience
 - Monthly System Performance Reports (MSPRs)
 - Utility System Condition Assessments (USCAs)
 - Capabilities for Black/Dry Start Exercises



- Capital Project Planning & Approval
 - Annual System Deficiency Corrections/Upgrades/Connections and Renewals and Replacements Plan
 - System Deficiency Corrections
 - Project Justification & Value Statement, e.g.,
 - Asset Reduction
 - Regulatory Driven
 - Commodity Savings
 - Reliability, Redundancy, etc.
 - Service-Specific Review and Approval Procedures



- Integrating AI Into Utility Operations
 - Project Management
 - System Modeling / Digital Twins
 - Integrating geospatial data
 - Pre-planning for system contingencies
 - Leak Detection / Forecasting
 - Inventory Management
 - Maintenance Activities
 - Identifying actual system conditions
 - Logical scheduling / groupings of work



- Contracting Officer Representative (COR) as a Resource
 - Utilities Privatization contracts provide an appointed COR on-site to assist the system owner demonstrating performance
 - CORs often have significant experience with the systems prior to privatization
 - CORs connect system owners with every tenant (individual / organization / mission) on the installation
 - CORs contribute to routine programmatic engagements with other CORs around the program
 - Sharing ground-level experiences
 - Ensuring they are aware of best practices
 - Promoting consistent support to SOs serving all the Military Services
