OVERVIEW

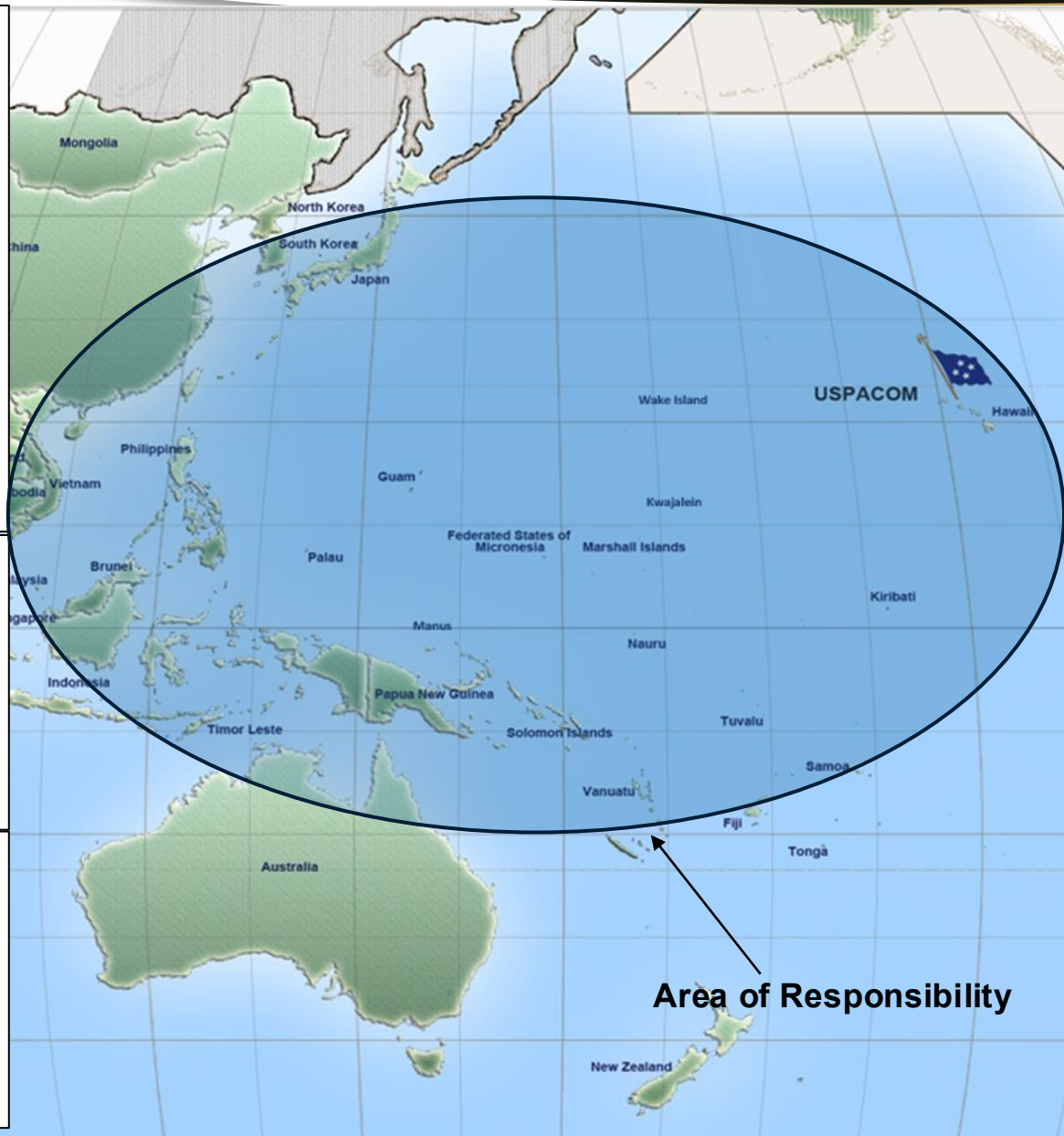
- Headquartered at Joint Base Pearl Harbor Hickam (JBPHH)

Overview

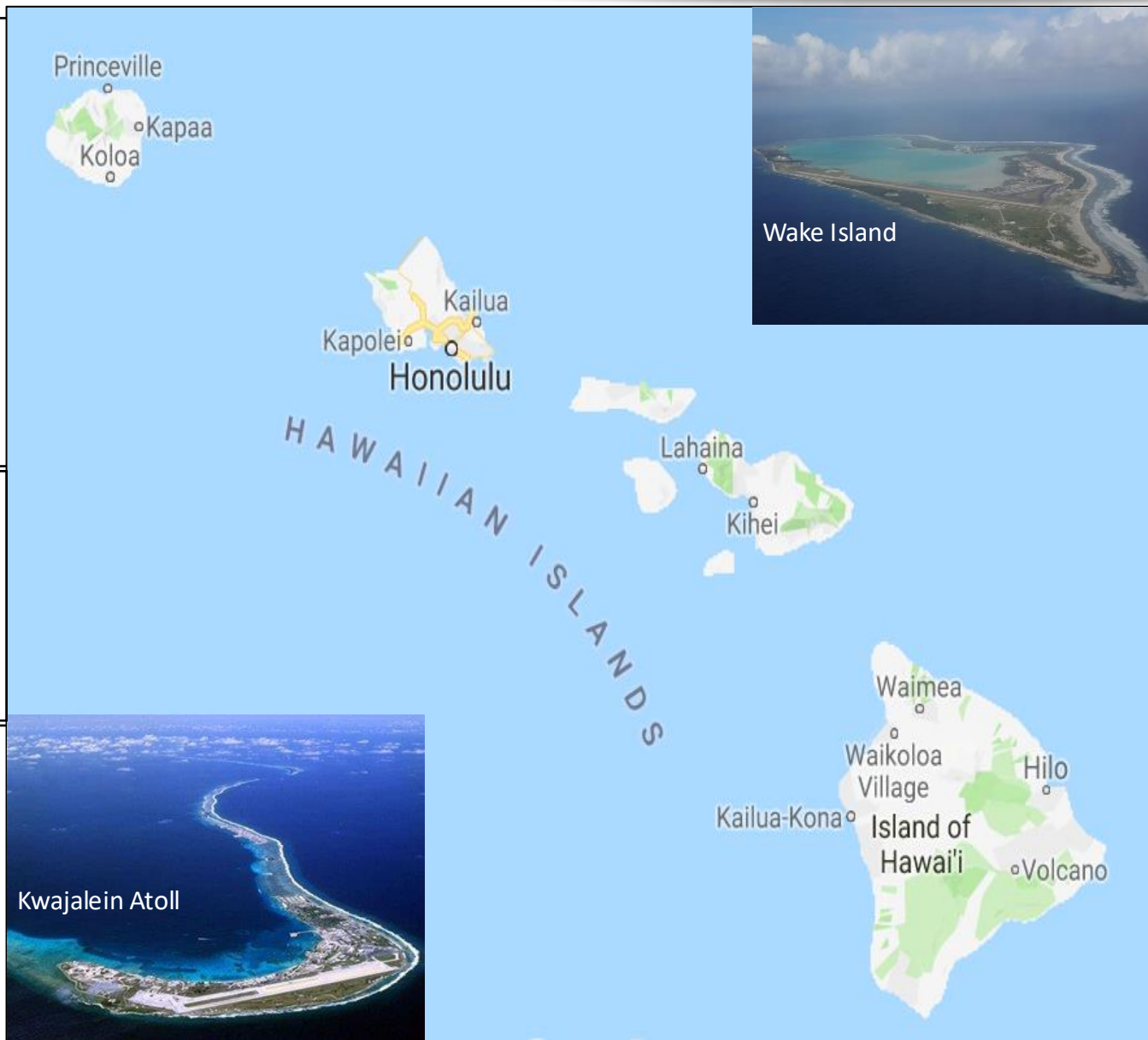
