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DLA Energy Fuel Card Programs

- Fuel Card programs include the:
 - DoD Fleet Card
 - Logistics (LOG) Fuel Card
 - Swipe Ships' Easy Acquisition (SEA) Card®
 - SEA Card®
 - U.S. Government Aviation Into- Plane Reimbursement (AIR) Card®
- DLA Energy Card Program Office performs overall program management responsibilities, training and support for DLA Energy's customer purchasing tools used worldwide
- DLA Energy Fuel Card Program policy is P-8
- DLA Energy Class IIIB commercial fuel cards support the warfighter and federal agencies
- Mission critical support
- Team responsible for managing commercial fuel requirements (DLA form 2053) for Into-plane and Bunkers

U.S. Government Aviation Into-Plane Reimbursement (AIR) Card®



- Supports US Government owned aircraft, refueling vehicles (into-truck), and bladders in procuring global commercial aviation fuel and fuel related services at commercial airports
 - AIR Card® can be used on DOD installations (please reference DFSP policy for guidance)
- DLA Energy Into-plane contract locations, the AIR Card® is the sole payment mechanism
 - Physical card solution
- Retail fixed base operators should only be used when a DFSP, International Agreement and/or DLA Energy Into-plane contract don't provide fuel support

- 184M Gallons Contract Fuel
 - 227K Transactions
- 58M Gallons Non-Contract Fuel
 - 75K Transactions

- Use of the AIR Card® constitutes a Government Order for Class IIIB Fuel and fuel related services in accordance with the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR)
- Using the AIR Card® for other than authorized products and services may result in disciplinary or legal action

Ships' Easy Acquisition (SEA) Card®



- Secure internet application that supports bunker fuel procurements at commercial locations
- Electronically connects DLA Energy bunker merchants (Contract and Open Market) to vessel ordering officers, accountable officials, and the contracting officers
- To be used at global seaports providing marine fuel for large vessels

FY25 Details:

- 53M Gallons Contract Fuel
 - 857 Transactions
- 55M Gallons Non-Contract Fuel
 - 693 Transactions

DoD FLEET Card

- Allows for the purchase of retail fuel, oil, vehicle accessories, repair, and emergency roadside services
 - Provides minor maintenance and roadside assistance support

 - Physical card solution
- Accepted at more than 450,000 commercial CONUS locations
 - OCONUS FLEET Card is available

- 12M Gallons Non-Contract Fuel
 - 475K Transactions



Swipe (SEA) Card®

- Designed for vessels that can not participate in the SEA Card® program
 - Physical card solution

- Credit Card solution that's accepted worldwide for fuel only
- Used at marinas for gas-and-go type situations

- 8M Gallons Non-Contract Fuel
 - 24K Transactions



Logistics (LOG) Fuel Card

- The Log Card program was launched to all authorized DLA Energy DoD and Federal customers on April 1, 2022
 - Physical card solution

- Program was established as a means to fill the purchasing gap for when other DLA Energy solutions may not be able to support the refueling of storage tanks
 - I.e. low quantity requirements and/or locations that don't have available long-term contracts
- The program is a fuel only program
 - All taxes, fees (i.e. processing fees) should be part of the final unit price.

FY25 Details:

- 769K Gallons Non-Contract Fuel
 - 2.1K Transactions



Transaction Processing

- Fuel Transactions
 - Fuel paid by DLA Energy and customer billed by Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS)
 - Standard price (military and DoD agencies) or cost-plus (Fed Civ)
- Non-Fuel Transactions
 - Invoiced directly to card account from the Card Provider
 - Account must reimburse Card Provider by invoice due date
 - Card account responsible for certifying non-fuel purchases



Card Program Training

- Accountable Official Training
 - Ensure training is complete prior to official assignment
 - Ensure refresher training is completed every three years
- Card User Training
 - Ensure training is complete prior to card usage

Audit Readiness and Risk Management



- Prevent Fraud, Abuse and Misuse
 - Sampling
 - Accountable Official (AO) reviews/validation *(Revised)*
 - Delinquencies *(Revised)*
 - Duplicate Filters
 - Dispute
 - Fraud alerts (where applicable)



Audit Readiness and Risk Management

- Authorization Control Limits
 - Price Reasonableness
 - Fuel Capacity
 - PIN Number
 - Profiles (dollar limits)
 - Strategic Sourcing
