

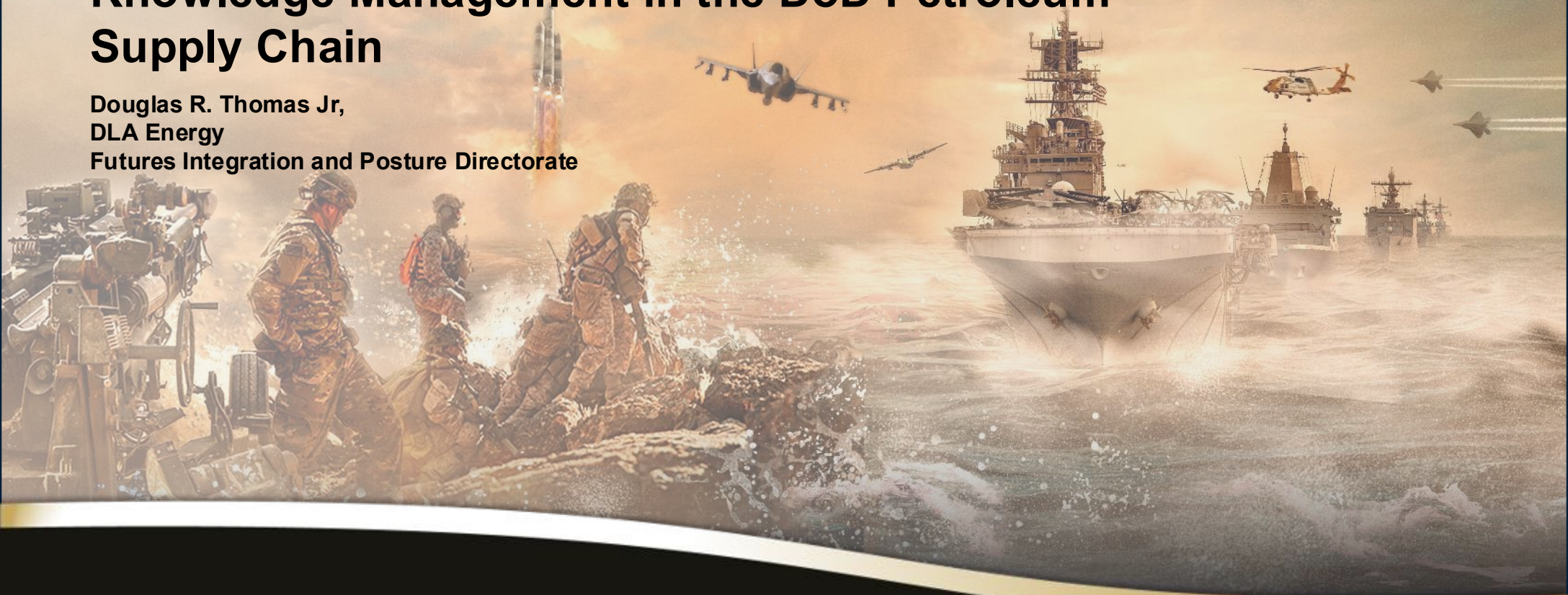

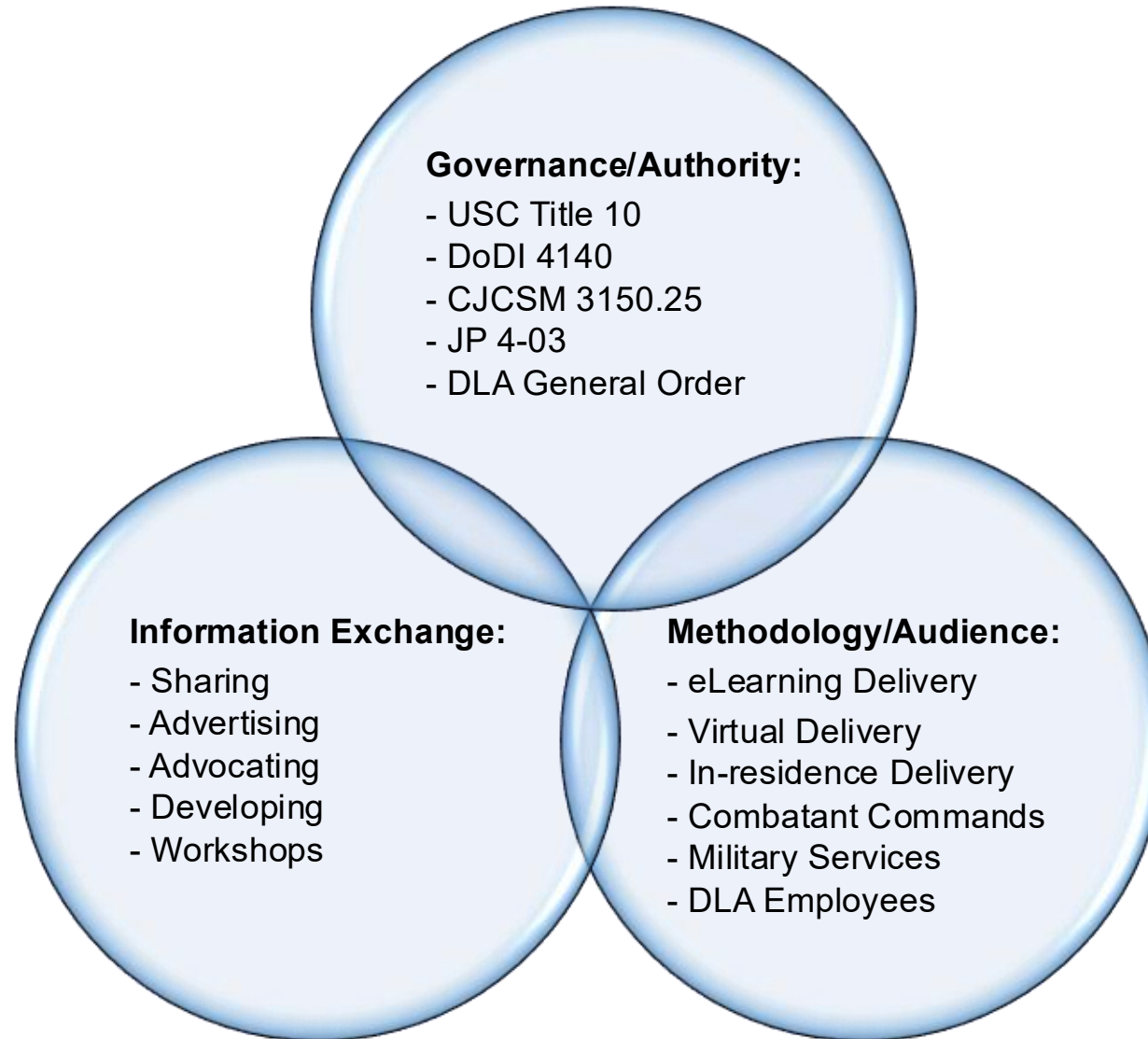

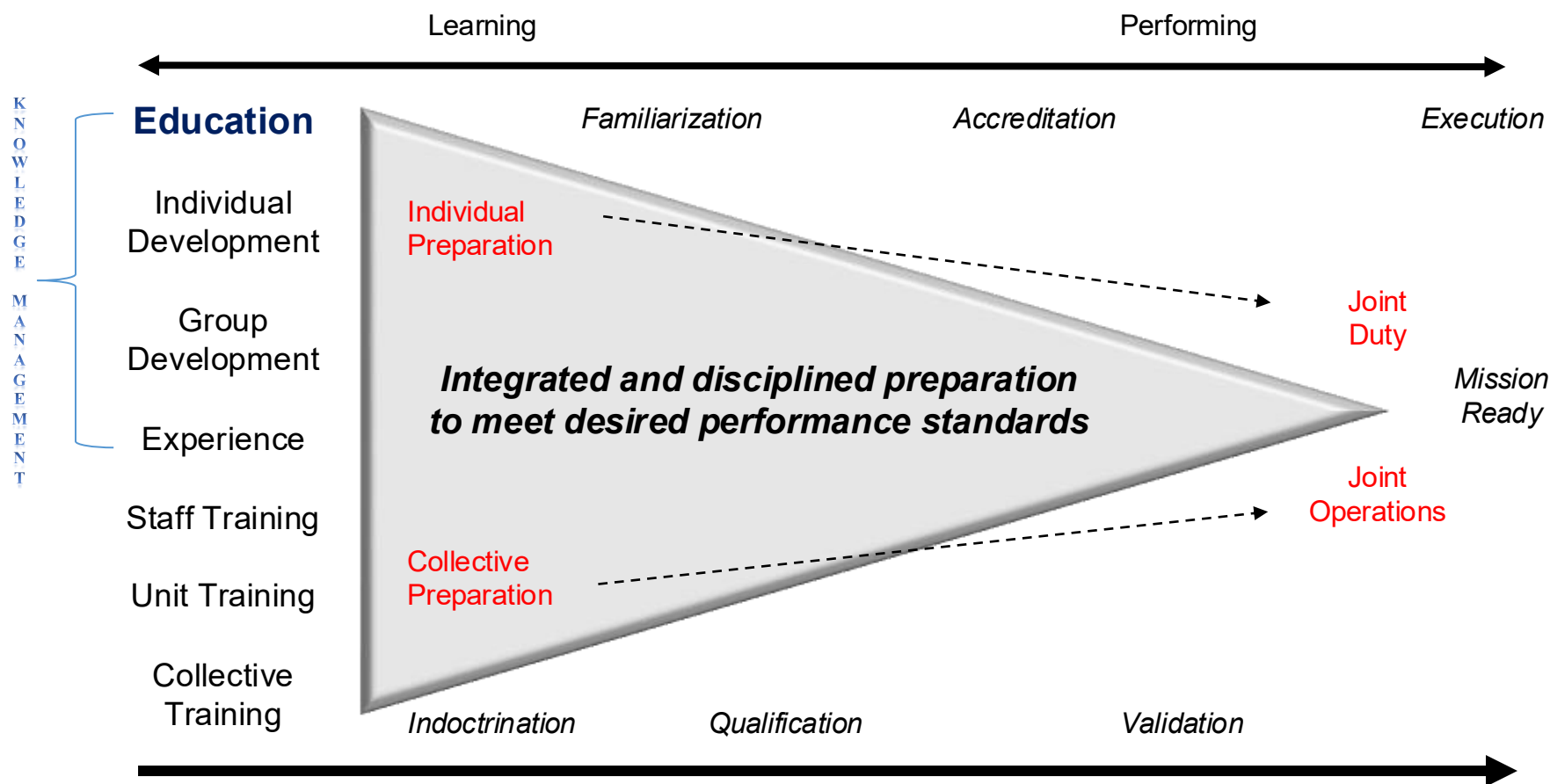

Foundational Landscape



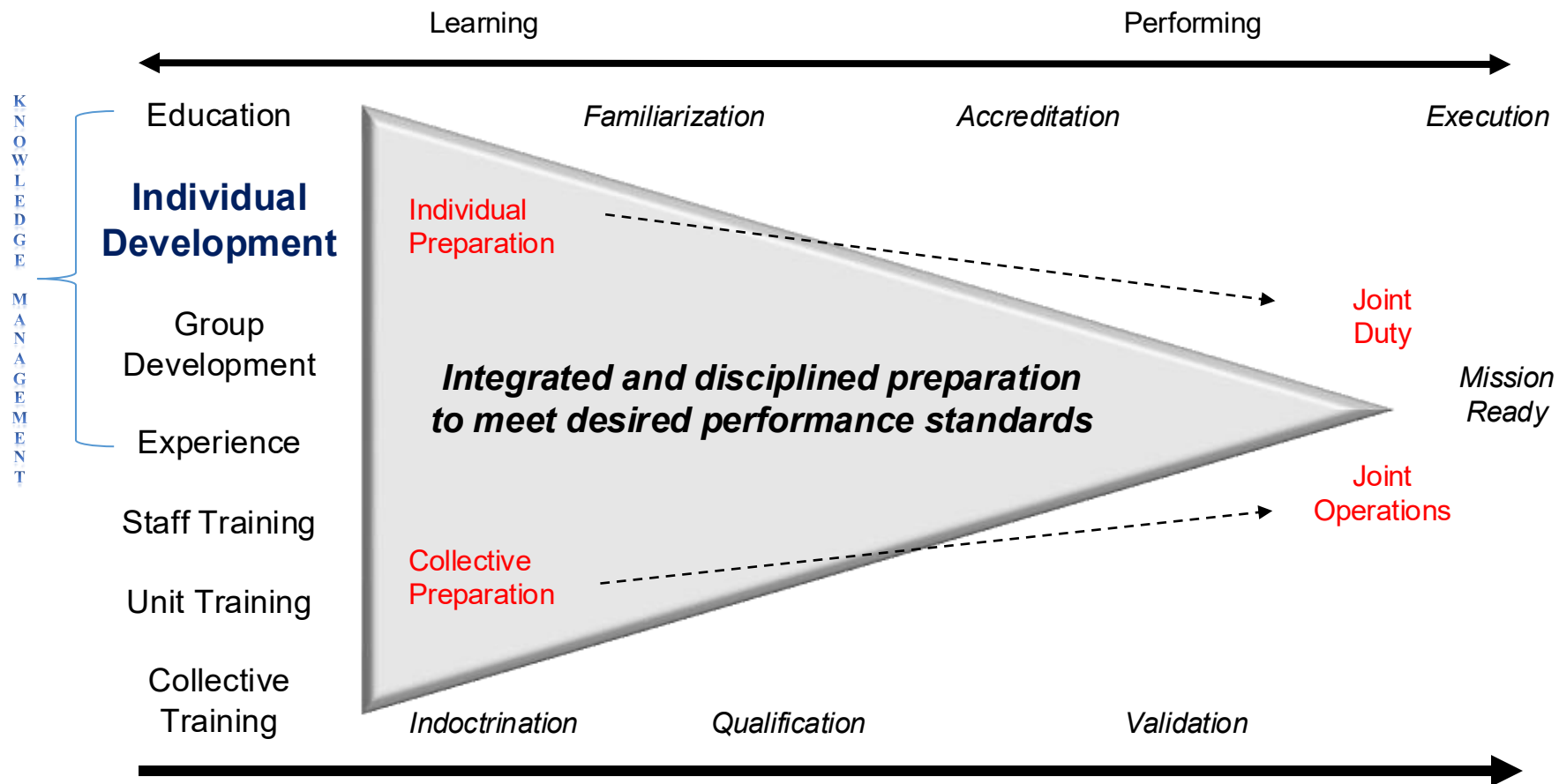


Joint Petroleum Training and Warfighter Support



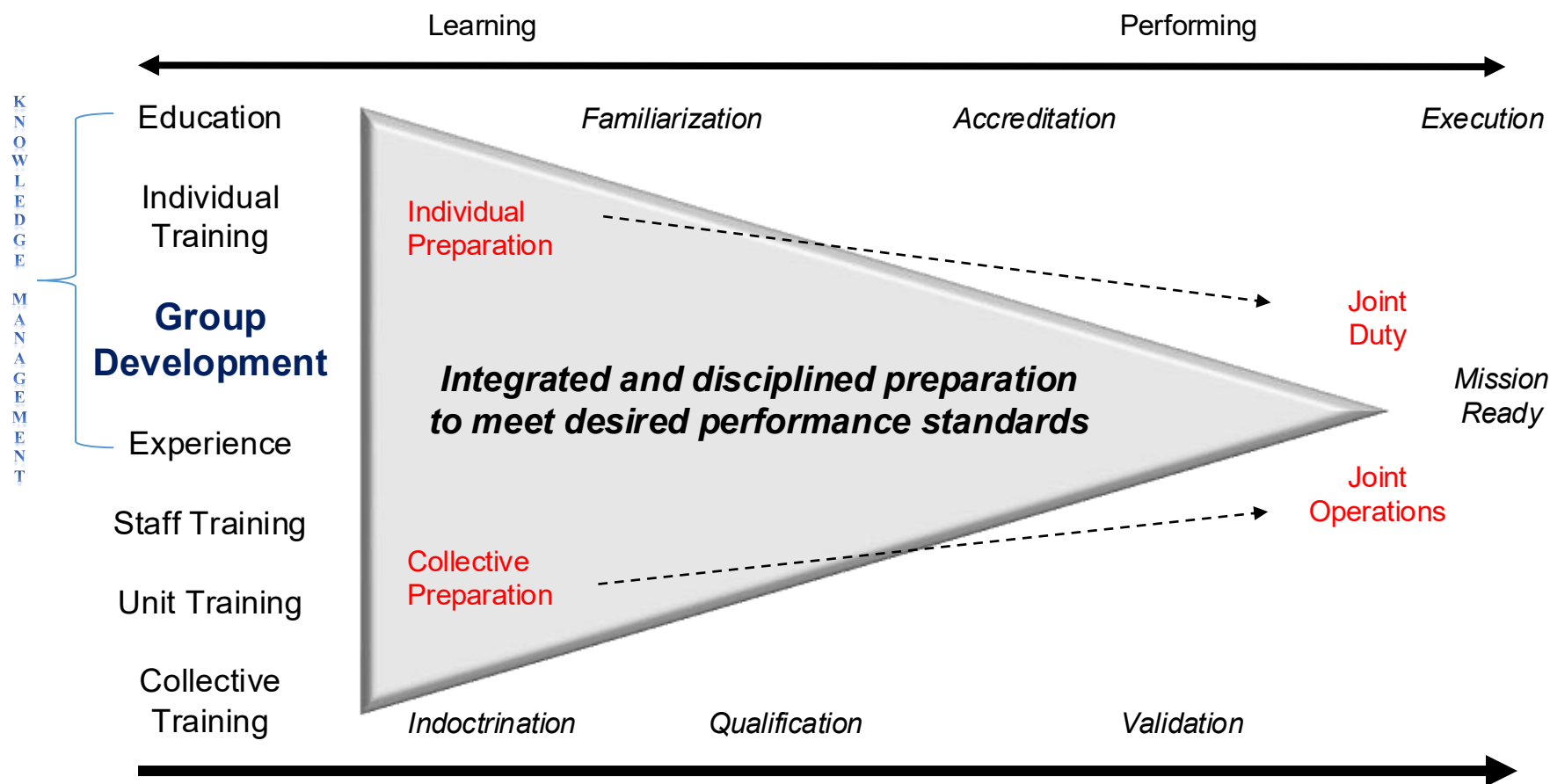

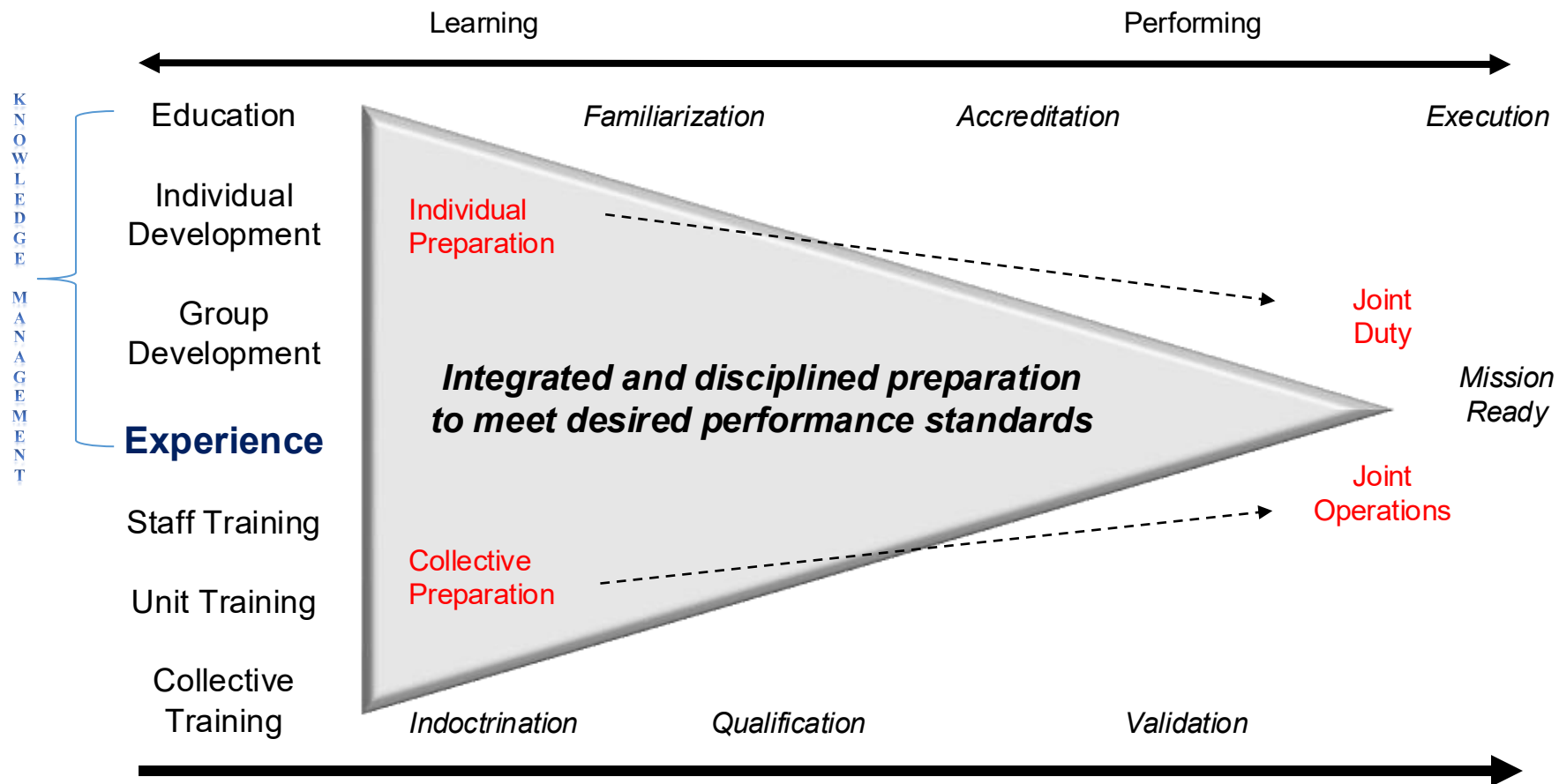

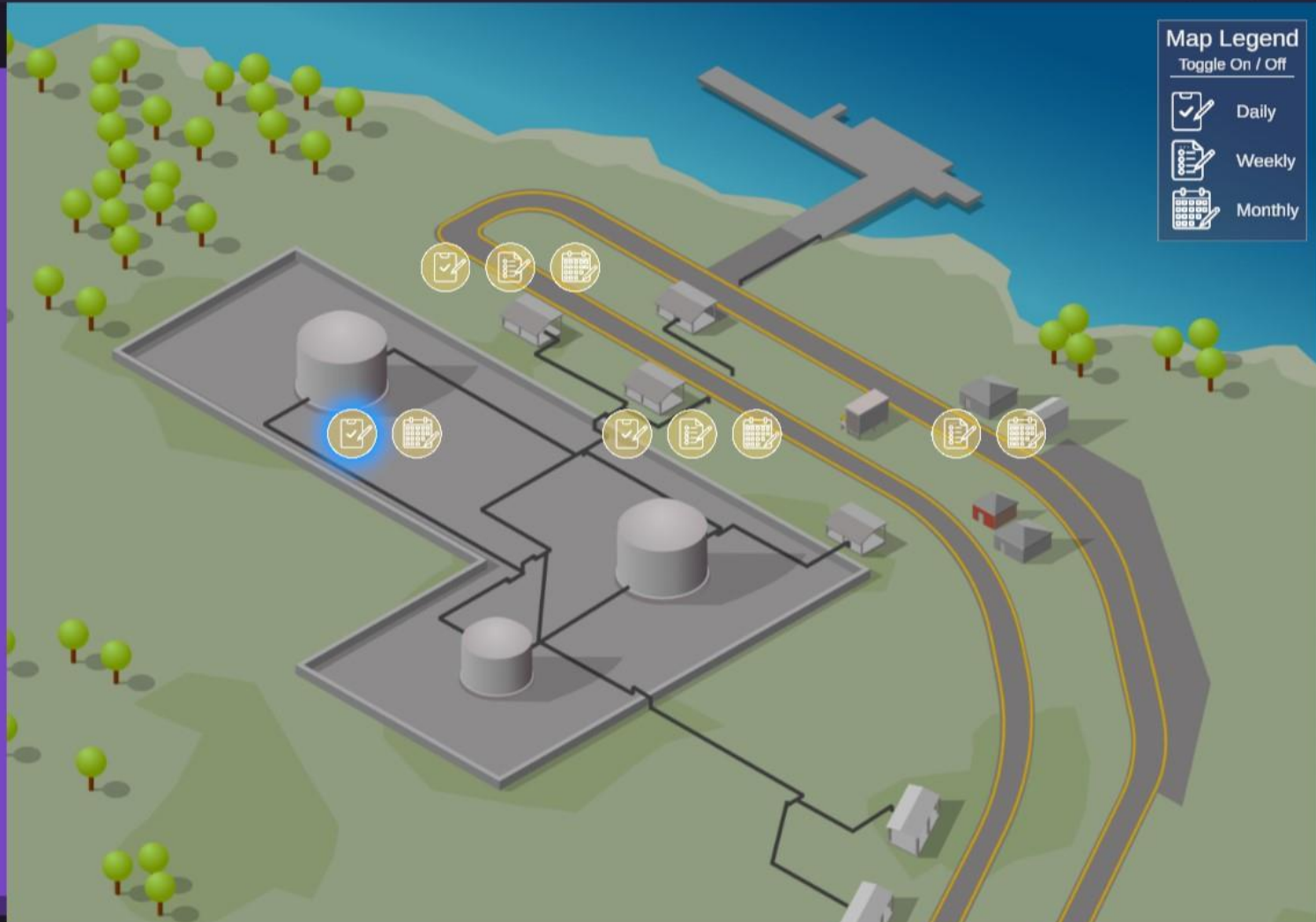

Joint Petroleum Course 200 – In-Residence or Virtual Delivery

This course is designed to provide students with a thorough understanding of Joint Petroleum Doctrine. The course is built upon the primary joint doctrine governing bulk liquids, focusing on the critical responsibilities and procedures for planning and conducting these operations. This approach ensures a thorough understanding of the subject, grounded in established official guidance.

The key distinction between the training deliveries is the in-residence course allows the opportunity for students to engage in face-to-face interactions with their fellow joint petroleum partners. Furthermore, it provides tours of petroleum laboratories, equipment, and DFSP facilities, offering students a practical, hands-on experience to complement their theoretical knowledge.

Joint Petroleum Course (JPC) 300

This is a 10-day course designed to provide advanced petroleum training to individuals who serve or are projected to serve within a Military Service headquarters, combatant command, joint petroleum, or sub-area petroleum office. The course provides a thorough understanding of Joint Petroleum Doctrine with a strong emphasis on the responsibilities, planning, execution, and control of joint petroleum operations. To ensure a thorough understanding of the material, the curriculum is supplemented with information from various key publications on planning, reporting, and international protocols.
